

## Your Comfort & Safety

**Toilets:** There is a single unisex toilet in the room to the right of the church entrance area. There is also a toilet and a disabled toilet in the building at the rear of the church.



**In Case of Emergency:** If the church building needs to be evacuated for any reason, please remain calm and follow the instructions of the leader. Please exit through the side door closest to you and assemble on the lawn area in front of the church. Please assist anyone nearby if you are able. Wait in the area until you are advised that it is safe to leave the property.

## Children are Welcome!

**Children are always welcome** at St. John's. If you have a preschool child with you, you are welcome to sit in the first or second pew on the right hand side and have them use the activity area that is available. If you have a primary school child with you there are kid's activity sheets on the entrance table, or you can ask an usher for a visitor's activity pack that contains materials of interest to children.



For **child safety** reasons, please supervise any children who are with you at all times and accompany them to the toilets etc.

A children's ministry program called **K-MOTION** is offered during school term-time in connection with our 10 am Worship Service. Families with children attending K-MOTION are asked to come forward to receive Holy Communion first, after which the children will be led from the worship space to the upstairs hall behind the church building.

## Holy Communion

At St. John's we regularly celebrate Holy Communion. We believe that Jesus Christ is truly present in, with and under the bread and wine of this holy meal. We invite all baptized believers who desire the forgiveness and renewal that Jesus brings to share this meal together with us. Alternatively you may come forward with your arms crossed over your chest to receive a blessing. If you are unsure about receiving Holy Communion, please see our Pastor before the Service begins.

### **Instructions for Receiving Holy Communion:**

- Please wait for an usher to invite you to come forward.
- Individual cups are available from a stand for those who do not wish to use the "common cup". These can be taken from the round silver trays. If there is a bottom tray it contains diluted wine in the outside circle and grape juice in the inside circle.
- Fill in around the rail, starting from the left hand side. You may kneel or stand.
- Please dispose of individual wine cups in the bowls provided on each side of the church as you return to your seat.
