

IMPORTANT UPDATE FROM ST. JOHN'S ELECTION AND BUDGET PRESENTATION MEETING

Last Sunday your Church Council team was elected (mostly re-elected!!!) to continue the organisation behind the smooth and safe administration that enables you to worship freely. There was one notable exception, the resignation of our previous treasurer, Jason Krenske. With the increased work demands of a very involved job and increasing involvement with his family, Jason found he was struggling to find the time for the input required for such an important role. During his 7 years as St John's treasurer, he has provided an extremely professional and comprehensive level of looking after the finances of our congregation and setting up our investment account to assist the offering shortfall. We have appreciated his efforts and, while we understand his reasons for resigning, we will miss his contribution.

With his training and assistance, Judy Krenske has offered to carry out this essential role and been elected as Treasurer. Please pray for her and support her as she eases into the position.

Jason's Budget Report for 2025 has some alarming statistics and I would like to bring those to your attention but this is only the start of a promotion that I would like to see well established before our new pastor commences. Jason announced that there is roughly a \$20,000 shortfall in our giving to date. This is alarming and affects the viability of our congregation. If we are required to draw on some of the capital of our investment account to pay the overheads of operating, that then obviously reduces the amount of money we can earn from it. Currently approximately 33% of our required income is from this source. There are a few reasons behind our giving shortfall and we will be addressing those in 2025. I understand times are tough with household budgets in the current economy and this is reflected in our financial position. Obviously if our worship numbers increase, this will help and I anticipate and pray that Pastor Bensted will attract more simply by his spiritual leadership and personality.

Please consider the amount of your personal free-will giving and also how you give as Regular Electronic Giving provides a steady income for the church. I understand and accept there are many reasons why you may not come to worship every week but unfortunately, the expenses still turn up even if you don't. I ask you to show your appreciation for your own blessings and the continued blessings of our congregation as we prepare to welcome and install Pastor Bensted probably on 9th March 2025. There are many more deserving congregations working through pastoral vacancies for months and even years in some cases.

Through all this, I am confident our Gracious God will provide but, as always, he needs us to be his willing children. *In His Service, Geoff Sampson.*
